SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE SUBRECIPIENT CONTRACT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND MY HEALTH MY RESOURCES OF TARRANT COUNTY FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION GRANT FOR COVID-19 HEALTH DISPARITIES

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Amendment No. 1 to the Subrecipient Contract between Tarrant County and My Health My Resources of Tarrant County (MHMR) for services related to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) grant for COVID-19 Health Disparities.

BACKGROUND

This CDC grant involves a national initiative to address health disparities among high-risk and underserved populations by improving testing and contact tracing, and capacity and response services to prevent and control COVID-19 infection.

MHMR utilizes this funding to provide health education toolkits for youth and adult clients with IDD, mental health issues, and families so that they may have age and developmentally appropriate information regarding health-related resources, vaccines, and mitigation strategies.

On June 8, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135624, approved a Notice of Award (NOA) for OT-2103 CDC COVID-19 Health Disparities grant funding in the amount of \$27,241,785.00 for the term of June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023.

On January 24, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #140173, approved NOA, #6 NH75OT000054-01-03, a no-cost extension, extending the CDC Grant budget and project period through May 31, 2024.

On January 23, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142491, approved a Subrecipient Contract with MHMR for grant funding in the amount of \$200,888.00 to provide COVID-19 education, developmental toolkits, and support identified clients.

On April 2, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142969 approved NOA, # 6 NH75OT000054-01-0 a second no-cost extension will be granted to extend the budget and project period to May 31, 2025.
