

RESOLUTION

State of Texas Office of the Governor – Criminal Justice Division Drug Impact Rehabilitation Enhanced Comprehensive Treatment (DIRECT) Court Grant

WHEREAS; The Commissioner's Court of Tarrant County finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Tarrant County, that the Drug Impact Rehabilitation Enhanced Comprehensive Treatment (DIRECT) program be operated by the Community Supervision and Corrections Department of Tarrant County for the 2025 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner's Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, that it will be the responsibility of the Community Supervision and Corrections Department of Tarrant County to return the funds to the Criminal Justice Division; and

WHEREAS; The Commissioner's Court of Tarrant County designates the Community Supervision and Corrections Department's Director to act as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant as per the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that the Tarrant County Commissioner's Court approve submission of the grant application for the Drug Impact Rehabilitation Enhanced Comprehensive Treatment program from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
