**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT RENEWAL
BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF EDGECLIFF
VILLAGE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES TO BE
PROVIDED BY THE TARRANT COUNTY SHERIFF'S
DEPARTMENT DURING FISCAL YEAR 2024**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) renewal with the Town of Edgecliff Village for law enforcement services for Fiscal Year 2024.

BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Department provides law enforcement services to the Town of Edgecliff Village under the terms of an ILA. An agreement was originally approved by the Commissioners Court in 1988, through Court Order #60690 and has been renewed annually. A new ILA was approved for FY 2004, through Court Order #91337 and outlined the services to be provided, along with compensation to the County. The County's only obligation to provide the law enforcement services in the agreement is through the Tarrant County Sheriff's Department.

The renewal agreement is for a period of one (1) year beginning October 1, 2023. The County will provide up to three (3) Sheriff's deputy positions in order to provide law enforcement services. Edgecliff Village will pay \$387,837.51. All other aspects of the ILA remain in full force and effect.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed the ILA as to form.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Town of Edgecliff Village's annualized payment to Tarrant County will increase to \$387,837.51, to be paid in monthly installments. The County's budget for FY 2024 includes three (3) Sheriff's deputy positions for the purpose of this agreement along with a revenue offset.
