**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
SETTING COMPENSATION OF
THE TARRANT COUNTY AUDITOR
AND ASSISTANT COUNTY AUDITORS
BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024**

On July 17, 2024, the District Judges, having first published all proper notices, held a Public Hearing, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code §152.905.

A quorum of the District Judges being present, and the District Judges having considered all information presented at the Public Hearing, the District Judges ORDER that the Tarrant County Auditor's and First Assistant Auditor's compensation, including travel expenses and car allowances, by Tarrant County of all types as of October 1, 2024 is set at the current amounts being paid and made available to said Auditor and First Assistant Auditor respectively, with the exceptions as follows:

The County Auditor's and First Assistant's annual salary and compensation will be increased or decreased in an amount equal to the percentage increase or decrease applied to other elected and appointed officials, paid out over the regular county pay periods covering work done beginning October 1, 2024. Compensation that is not awarded as a percentage increase or decrease but is awarded at a set amount shall be increased or decreased in the same amount as applied to other elected and appointed officials.

And the District Judges, having considered the matter of the compensation of the remaining Assistant County Auditors, ORDER that the Tarrant County Assistant Auditors' compensation of all types shall continue as is presently being paid to them until October 1, 2024, after which time the Assistant County Auditors' salaries will be increased or decreased based on merit and evaluations and any other applicable factors within the parameters of the County's budgeted merit or pay pool for the Auditor's office for fiscal year 2025, as budgeted and administered for other regular county employees.

For any Auditor and all Assistant County Auditors hired in, promoted, reassigned, or otherwise reviewed for compensation adjustments of any kind in the future, no additional order by the District Judges is required to pay the Auditor and Assistant County Auditors up to the amount currently being provided to the incumbent Auditor or Assistant County Auditor in a position to which a future Auditor or Assistant County Auditor is hired in, promoted, reassigned, or otherwise reviewed for compensation adjustment, or to pay other



benefits, including but not limited to across the board percentage or dollar amount salary or car allowance increases, or other payments or increases, that in the future are provided to regular full-time employees of Tarrant County.


In addition, should the County implement any across the board increases or decreases in salary, car allowance, or other compensation or benefits, the same increase or decrease shall apply to the Auditor or Assistant Auditors as to similarly compensated county officials or employees.

The District Clerk shall record this action and certify it to the Commissioners Court by forwarding a certified copy of this Order to the County Clerk so that the same will be received by the County Clerk and filed with the papers of the Tarrant County Commissioners Court and at such other proper places as the County Clerk shall determine.

This Order was adopted by a vote of 19 voting for and 0 voting against.

It is so ORDERED.
