RESOLUTION ADOPTING TARRANT COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, the Tarrant County Commissioners Court is the governing body of the Tarrant County Hospital District (JPS Health Network) and has the authority to set the district's tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the Tarrant County Commissioners Court seeks to be good stewards of taxpayers funds by administering an efficient and effective government; and

WHEREAS, the Tarrant County Commissioners Court has prioritized reducing the tax burden on property owners in Tarrant County; and

WHEREAS, the Tarrant County Commissioners Court increased the homestead exemption to 20% relating to the hospital district's ad valorem tax values for Tax Year 2024 on June 18, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 26.05, Tex. Tax Code, requires the Tarrant County Commissioners Court to vote on the property tax rate for Tax Year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the tax rate of \$0.1875 per \$100 in value is below the no-new-revenue rate and will decrease the property tax levy by \$18,626,606 (3.4%) from the previous year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tarrant County Commissioners Court adopts a maintenance and operations tax rate of \$0.17709 (per \$100 valuation) and an interest and sinking tax rate of \$0.010410 (per \$100 valuation) for a combined total tax rate of \$0.1875 (per \$100 valuation).
