**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SUBRECIPIENT CONTRACT WITH HEALTHY
TARRANT COUNTY COLLABORATION FOR SERVICES
RELATED TO THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL GRANT
FOR COVID-19 HEALTH DISPARITIES**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve a Subrecipient Contract with Healthy Tarrant County Collaboration for services related to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) grant for COVID-19 Health Disparities.

BACKGROUND

This CDC grant involves a national initiative to address health disparities among underserved, high-risk populations by improving testing and contact tracing, and capacity and response services to prevent and control COVID-19 infection.

On June 8, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135624, approved a Notice of Award for grant funding in the amount of \$27,241,785.00 for the term of June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023.

On September 28, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136492, approved a Subrecipient Contract with Healthy Tarrant County Collaboration for the provision of services related to this CDC grant. This contract provided funding in the amount of \$311,485.00 for for the term of June 1, 2021, through May 31, 2023.

On January 24, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #140173, approved a CDC Notice of Award, #6 NH75OT000054-01-03, a no cost extension, extending the CDC Grant budget and project period to May 31, 2024.

With approval of this Subrecipient Contract, Healthy Tarrant County Collaboration will receive funding in the amount of \$37,600.00 to increase community and cross-sectoral partnerships, reduce health disparities, and improve/increase testing and contact tracing among underserved, high-risk populations by mobilization of partners, including a team of 12 resident leaders to deliver health information to the residents in Stop Six.

The contract term takes effect upon the date of Commissioners Court approval and ends May 31, 2024.
