SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2026 GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION COMMUNITY YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Amendment No. 4 to the Fiscal Year 2022-2026 Grant Agreement with the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) for the Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Community Youth Development (CYD) Program, Contract No. HHS000841700005.

BACKGROUND

Since 1995, the CYD Grant, as part of the DFPS Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Programs, provides funding and technical assistance to afford community-based organizations the opportunity to foster positive youth development and build healthy families and resilient communities. CYD provides services in zip codes with high increases in juvenile crime. Communities prioritize and fund specific prevention services to address community-level needs. In April 1996, Tarrant County began the TCPH CYD Program through grant funds provided by the DFPS PEI CYD Grant Program to curb juvenile crime in the 76106 and 76164 zip codes.

On August 17, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136109, approved the most recent base grant contract with DFPS for FY 2022-2026 in an amount not to exceed \$3,281,250.00 over the term of the contract. The term of the contract is September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2026. Each fiscal year, DFPS provides specific Notices of Award (NOA) outlining the funding for that specific fiscal year.

On May 17, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #133153, approved Amendment No. 1 to FY 2022-2026 Grant Contract with DFPS for an additional \$75,000.00 for Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) under the statutory authority of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the CYD Innovation Grant.

On January 10, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #140075, approved Amendment No. 2 to FY 2022-2026 Grant Contract, increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$243,750 for a new total of \$3,600,000.00.

On December 5, 2023, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142263, approved Unilateral Amendment No. 1, the Uniform Terms and Conditions (UTC) to update and add new Grantee reporting requirements as a result of the passage of Senate Bill 182 (88th Regular Legislative Session).

On February 6, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #142575, approved Amendment No. 3 to the FY 2022-2026 Grant Contract, replacing Attachment A-2 (Statement of Work) with Attachment A-3 (Statement of Work).

With approval of Amendment No. 4, the FY 2022-2026 Grant Agreement will update Section VII (contract grant manager), Section VIII (DFPS Grant Uniform Terms and Conditions and DFPS Grant Supplemental and Special Conditions). Unless otherwise modified by this Amendment, this agreement will remain in full force and effect.

This amendment is effective July 15, 2024.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has approved Amendment No. 4 as to form.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no match requirement, indirect cost, or operating subsidy required for this grant.

Approval of this Amendment will have no impact on the County's General Fund.
