**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider approving the use of the Family Law Center for the Eldon B. Mahon Inn of Court High School Mock Trial Competition on Saturday, January 27, 2024 and Friday, February 2, 2024.

**BACKGROUND**

The Tarrant County Bar Association has requested the use of various courtrooms in the Family Law Center for the upcoming 2024 Region 11 Texas High School Mock Trial Competition. The Family Law Center building accommodations have aided in the success of the event for the past several years.

There will be approximately six (6) high schools from Tarrant County and surrounding counties participating in the competition.

Expansion courtrooms on the 4th floor, and the 2nd floor Assembly Room of the Family Law Center as well as the 231st, 231st Associate Judge (AJ), 233rd, 233rd AJ, Child Protection Court No. 1 and No. 2 have been reserved for this event.

In addition to their normal business day security, the Sheriff's Office has agreed to provide security during the non-business hours of this competition.

**FISCAL IMPACT**
