**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF UNILATERAL AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2026 GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE TARRANT COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION COMMUNITY YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Unilateral Amendment No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 2022-2026 Grant Agreement with the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) for the Tarrant County Public Health Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Community Youth Development (CYD) program, contract #HHS0008417005.

**BACKGROUND**

Since 1995, DFPS PEI CYD program has provided funding and technical assistance to give community-based organizations the opportunity to foster positive youth development and build healthy families and resilient communities. CYD provides services in zip codes with high incidences of juvenile crime. Communities prioritize and fund specific prevention services to address community-level needs.

On April 16, 1996, Commissioners Court, through Court Order #74131, approved the original CYD grant contract with DFPS PEI CYD program to curb juvenile crime in the 76106 and 76164 zip codes. Thereafter, renewals have been made to continue the program.

On August 17, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136109, approved the most recent base grant contract, for FY 2022-2026 with a term of September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2026, for grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$3,281,250.00 over the term of the contract. DFPS provides specific Fiscal Year annual funding through Notices of Award (NOA).

On May 17, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #138153, approved Amendment No. 1 to FY 2022-2026 grant contract with DFPS for an additional \$75,000.00 for Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention under the statutory authority of the American Rescue Plan Act for the CYD Innovation Grant. The Total Amount of this Grant, Statement of Work, Contract (Grant) Manager, and attachments were modified.
