**SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PROGRAM  
YEAR 2023 CONTINUUM OF CARE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND THE SALVATION ARMY -  
ARLINGTON FOR THE TBLA 114 RAPID REHOUSING PROGRAM**

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court consider Amendment No. 1 to the Program Year (PY) 2023 Continuum of Care Subrecipient Agreement between Tarrant County and The Salvation Army - Arlington for the TBLA 114 Rapid Rehousing (RRH) Program, Grant #TX0113L6T012316.

**BACKGROUND**

On May 21, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143131, approved a Subrecipient Agreement between Tarrant County and The Salvation Army - Arlington to provide \$41,379.00 in interim funding for the TBLA 114 RRH Program to ensure continuity of services.

On August 20, 2024, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #143658, approved the FY 2023 CoC Program Grant Agreement with HUD to provide Tarrant County with \$1,447,646.00 in grant funding to support the TBLA 114 RRH Program. The awarded grant funds will be used to reimburse Tarrant County for the interim funds referenced above and provide the remaining award balance to various subrecipients. Tarrant County retains fifty percent (50%) of the \$116,258.00 Administrative Costs allowance within the grant budget.

With approval of Amendment No. 1, Tarrant County will provide The Salvation Army - Arlington with \$90,596.00 in additional TBLA 114 grant funds, bringing the total grant award to \$131,975.00. Funding will be used to support the TBLA 114 RRH Program, which provides services to households experiencing homelessness within Tarrant County. These services include rapid rehousing, rental assistance, transportation, and general case management. Reimbursement will not exceed the following amounts:

Rental Assistance	<u>\$125,961.00</u> (including \$41,379.00 in interim funding)
Total	\$131,975.00

The term of the Agreement shall remain from May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025.

On May 21, 2024, Tarrant County and **The Salvation Army** entered into the above-referenced contract (the "Contract"). By notice of this letter, Tarrant County proposes to amend the Contract concerning the following terms contained within the **Term of Agreement** as follows:

**SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Agency shall provide eligible services at the levels agreed upon in the current HUD approved Grant Application to the homeless population within Tarrant County during the term of this agreement.

*Approved Budget:* The total one-year project budget for the 2023 Continuum of Care Program TBLA 114 (Grant Number Pending) Grant is expected to be \$1,447,646.00. Pending grant agreements with HUD, interim financing was approved through Commissioners Court to ensure continuity of services. Tarrant County will reimburse Agency out of the project budget for the following expenditures, but not to exceed the following total amounts:






