COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve a Participation Agreement between Tarrant County and Washington/Baltimore High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (W/B HIDTA) for the Overdose Detection Mapping Application Program (ODMAP).

BACKGROUND

ODMAP provides near real-time suspected overdose data across jurisdictions to support public safety and public health efforts to mobilize an immediate response to a sudden increase, or spike, in overdose events. ODMAP links first responders and relevant record management systems to a mapping tool to track overdoses to stimulate real-time response and strategic analysis across jurisdictions.

TCPH will not be sharing any data with ODMAP. TCPH will use ODMAP to monitor overdose trends and identify spikes in overdose activity. TCPH will use this information to raise awareness, facilitate data-driven decisions, and work with community partners to implement effective intervention strategies.

With approval, current TCPH staff will gain access to the mapping application program to monitor trends as outlined above. The term of this Participating Agreement will be in effect upon approval by both parties and will stay in effect until terminated by either party.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed this document as to form.
