It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve the Attorney Employment Agreement engaging Tammy Ardolf with Taylor, Olson, Adkins, Sralla & Elam, LLP as outside counsel re: defense for former Tarrant County employee Jonathan Nymoen.

BACKGROUND

Tarrant County employee Jonathan Nymoen has been sued in an inmate civil rights case. Pursuant to Local Government Code Section 157.901, it is necessary for outside counsel to be employed to represent this individual in the lawsuit entitled Anthony R. Johnson, Sr., et al. v. Tarrant County, Texas, et al., Civil Action No. 4:24-cv-686-O in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Fort Worth Division.

With approval of this action, former Tarrant County employee Jonathan Nymoen will have representation in this federal suit.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact associated with this action is unknown at this time, however, the law firm is to use all reasonable means to resolve this matter at a total cost of no more than \$30,000.00, subject to further court approval.
