**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court accept monthly donations of infant supplies from the Junior League of Fort Worth (JLFW) Diaper Bank to the Tarrant County Public Health (TCPH) Department.

**BACKGROUND**

The JLFW is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women, and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. In 2020, the JLFW launched its Diaper Bank initiative to serve as a mobilizer and connector for diaper needs in Tarrant County. JLFW partners with community agencies to distribute diapers and wipes to Tarrant County families in need, on a monthly basis, with no contractual agreement by either party.

TCPH's Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) program provides personalized nursing services to women in Tarrant County throughout pregnancy and until the infant reaches 2 years old. This program consists of assisting the mother in achieving a healthy pregnancy, ensuring the home is a safe place for the infant to live and play, setting goals for the family's future, and finding ways to continue education and develop job skills.

If accepted, TCPH will receive a monthly donation of diapers and wipes to distribute to NFP program participants. The infant supplies are valued at approximately \$645.00 per month.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

There will be no fiscal impact to the County's General Fund.
