

- ✓ FEMA & TDEM obligate funds
- Monitor and report on activities

Tarrant County Pillars of Focus

COVID-19 Testing

- There are ~18 permanent and roving testing locations across the County along with community and retail partners
- Tarrant County is supporting and assisting all testing locations as needed
- The County will continue to launch and assist additional testing sites

Economic Stimulus

- Small Business Assistance Grant Program
 - First round closed July 6^{th;} final determinations made, and grants awarded
 - Second round opened
 October 26th
 - Second round closed on November 10th
 - Grants being awarded on an ongoing basis



Social Services

- Rental Assistance Program
 - Launched June 22nd
 - Application deadline is December 9th
- NGO Assistance Program
 - Closed July 21st; final recommendations completed
 - County providing ongoing support and issuing monthly reimbursements



Local Partners

- ILA Distribution Program
 - County touching base with municipalities to ensure all CRF funds will be incurred by the Dec. 30th deadline
 - Identifying potential duplication of benefits between municipal and County programs
 - County working with other partner agencies to provide CRF funding assistance for eligible reimbursements


