

FIRST AMENDMENT TO ARTWORK LOAN AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

This First Amendment to Artwork Loan Agreement and Release (“Amendment”) is entered into effect as of Tarrant County Commissioners Court approval, between Art Fairchild (“Owner”) and TARRANT COUNTY TEXAS (“County”).

RECITALS

A. County and Owner entered into an “Artwork Loan Agreement and Release” (“Agreement”) on September 6, 2016 as reflected in Commissioners Court Order Number 123367, placing Owner’s sculpture entitled “Sator Cube” in front of the Tarrant County Subcourthouse in Arlington, located at 700 E. Abram Street, Arlington, Texas 76010.

B. The Agreement ran for an initial period of five (5) years from September 6, 2016.

C. The “Sator Cube” continues to be displayed at the same location and the Owner and County desire by this Amendment to extend the Agreement to allow for its continued display.

NOW THEREFORE, County and Owner agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 4 of the Agreement is modified to extend the term of the Agreement to June 22, 2022. The Agreement is understood by Owner and County to have continuously functioned in full effect with no uncovered gap period from the end of the initial five (5) year period until June 22, 2022.
2. Except as amended herein, the Agreement is unchanged.
