RENEWAL OF DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR TARRANT COUNTY

WHEREAS County Judge B. Glen Whitley, pursuant to 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code, issued a Declaration of Local Disaster for Tarrant County on July 29, 2022, due to an imminent threat of severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from the threat of wildfires due to drought, extreme temperatures, and high winds; and

WHEREAS the County of Tarrant on the 2nd day of August 2022 remains under an imminent threat of severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from the threat of wildfires due to drought, extreme temperatures, and high winds; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge and the Commissioners of Tarrant County have determined that extraordinary measures shall continue to be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED by the County Judge and the Commissioners of Tarrant County:

1. That a state of local disaster continues to exist in Tarrant County;
2. That the Declaration of Local Disaster for Tarrant County proclaimed by County Judge B. Glen Whitley on July 29, 2022 (“Declaration”) is hereby renewed for period of ninety (90) days unless continued, renewed, or cancelled by the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County;
3. That the Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Tarrant County pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code;
4. Pursuant to Chapter 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration affirms the activation of the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans, including the Tarrant County Emergency Management Plan, and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance.
