AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL CONTRACT
Amendment Number 2

THIS INTERLOCAL AMENDMENT is made by and between the State of Texas acting by and through the Texas Department of Transportation, (TxDOT), and County of Tarrant (Local Government), and shall become effective when fully executed by both parties.

BACKGROUND

The TxDOT and the Local Government executed a contract on August 6, 2019, concerning the purposes of Courtesy Patrol Services: Free and clear roadways, assist stalled and stranded motorist and assist law enforcement with traffic control when deemed necessary or when asked by law enforcement.

This amendment is identical to Amendment Number 1 (executed July 28, 2022), which was inadvertently signed at authority level below that required by statute. This amendment is to merely allow the ratification of Amendment Number 1 by the correct signature authority.

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting parties to the above numbered Interlocal Contract to amend the contract as follows:

AGREEMENT

- I. Section V. Term of Contract is extended from August 31, 2022 to October 31, 2022, to allow the State time to execute a new interlocal agreement so that there is no gap in services.

All other terms and conditions of the above numbered Interlocal Contract not hereby amended remain in full force and effect.
