

## ***Proclamation J.D. Johnson***

***WHEREAS, J.D. Johnson is the longest tenured Tarrant County Commissioner in Tarrant County history having served Precinct 4 since 1987; and***

***WHEREAS, as a former mayor of Saginaw and then as County Commissioner, he has proudly represented northwest Tarrant County and all of Tarrant County; and***

***WHEREAS, he is the first Tarrant County Commissioner to receive a gubernatorial appointment to the Texas Commission on Jail Standards and worked as the Commissioners Court liaison with the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office, where he helped sponsor seminars to educate law enforcement groups on terrorism and homeland security; and***

***WHEREAS, he is former president of the Texas Association of Counties, the County Judges and Commissioners Association of Texas as well as the West Texas County Judges and Commissioners Association; and***

***WHEREAS, during his time County Commissioner, J.D. Johnson has served as the Court's liaison to the Tarrant County Sheriff's Department, the Tarrant County Emergency Services District No. 1, the Tarrant County 9-1-1 Emergency Assistance District, the Tarrant County Medical Examiner's Office, the Tarrant County Bail Bond Board, the Criminal Justice Council and the Purchasing Agent Board; and***

***WHEREAS, with a lifelong passion for 4-H and FFA clubs across Tarrant County, he was honored by the Texas Cooperative Extension multiple times for his work and named to the Board of Directors of the Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo.***

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby commend and recognize the outstanding achievements of Commissioner J.D. Johnson and express our deep respect and appreciation for his many years of dedicated public service to the citizens of Tarrant County.***
