WHEREAS, Judge Brent Carr proudly served in the United States Marine Corps from 1976 through 1993 receiving the Navy Achievement Medal, Lifesaving during his service; and

WHEREAS, he met his wife, Lesli, at MD Anderson Hospital in 1979 where she was a nurse for his brother, David, and he was David's bone marrow donor; and

WHEREAS, after graduating from the South Texas College of Law in 1983, he began his career for Tarrant County as an Assistant District Attorney; and

WHEREAS, since assuming the office of Judge for Tarrant County Criminal Court Number 9 in September 1991, Judge Carr has presided over 1,000 jury trials and over 75,000 case depositions; and

WHEREAS, Judge Carr has presided over the Mental Health Diversion Court; Veterans Treatment Court, RISE Anti Sex-Trafficking Program for Female Offenders, and served as the Supervising and Consulting Judge for the Enhanced Mental Health Services Docket for Tarrant County; and

WHEREAS, Judge Carr's leadership includes service on the Texas Specialty Court Advisory Council, Texas Judicial Commission on Mental Health, Tarrant County Homeless Coalition Continuity of Care Board and as the Inaugural President on the Veterans Coalition of Tarrant County; and

WHEREAS, additionally, he served as an Adjunct Professor – Criminal Justice at Tarrant County College for 21 years and was named 2013 Adjunct Professor of the Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby honor the service of County Criminal Court Number 9 Judge Brent Carr and recognize his 31 years of distinguished service to the citizens of Tarrant County.
