WHEREAS, Judge Glen Whitley, a civic leader and certified public accountant, was born in Grand Prairie, Texas, and graduated from Grand Prairie High School in 1971; and

WHEREAS, Judge Glen Whitley earned an accounting degree from the University of Texas at Arlington, served in the U.S. Naval Reserve, and co-founded the accounting firm Whitley Penn in 1983; and

WHEREAS, his public service includes past chairman of Harris Methodist H-E-B Hospital Board, Board of Trustees Member for the Hurst-Euless-Bedford Independent School District, member of the H-E-B Economic Development Task Force, and serving on many other civic and community associations; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, he was elected as Precinct 3 Tarrant County Commissioner and as Tarrant County Judge in 2006,

WHEREAS, Judge Whitley is a leader on a wide range of issues including transportation, efficient government, sustainable communities, higher education, youth and children's issues, and support for military veterans and military families; and

WHEREAS, he is a proud past president of the National Association of Counties, the West Texas County Judges and Commissioners Association of Texas, and of the North Central Texas Council of Governments, helping local governments develop policy, recognize regional opportunities and make collaborative decisions; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, Judge Whitley was nationally recognized by American City and County magazine as "County Leader of the Year."
