It is requested that the Commissioners Court accept ownership transfer of a laboratory safety enclosure from the Association of Public Health Laboratories (APHL).

BACKGROUND

On December 15, 2020, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #134447, approved the donation of a laboratory safety enclosure from APHL for use by the Tarrant County Public Health Department's North Texas Regional Laboratory (NTRL) for COVID-19 specimen processing. The safety enclosure equipment consisted of an air purifier unit, an epoxy work surface, and a stand. The total value of the equipment donation was approximately \$7,500.00.

With approval of this request, APHL transfers all remaining title and interest in and to the equipment to Tarrant County Public Health without restriction.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed this document as to form.


Dear Rune-Par Nilsson,

I am writing on behalf of the Association of Public Health Laboratories (APHL) to confirm the closeout of Cooperative Agreement NU60OE000103 (formerly 1U60OE000103) (CFDA #93.322) (the Cooperative Agreement) between APHL and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The Cooperative Agreement reached the end of its multi-year term and APHL has recently submitted to the federal government the final reports and documentation required under the Cooperative Agreement terms.
