COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve renewal of RFP No. 2021-051, Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction, Disposal, and Other Emergency Debris Related Services, for the second and final optional twelve (12) month period at the same contract terms.

BACKGROUND

On January 11, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #137231, approved renewal of RFP No. 2021-051, Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction, Disposal, and Other Emergency Debris Related Services, for Emergency Management, to the following vendors:

Primary	CrowderGulf, LLC
Secondary	Aftermath Disaster Recovery, Inc.
Alternate	Southern Disaster Recovery, LLC

The awards were based upon the evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP specifications and contained options to renew for two (2) additional twelve (12) month periods.

The vendors notified Purchasing in writing that they will extend the same contract terms through March 12, 2024. Emergency Management notified Purchasing in writing that they are pleased with the vendors and want to renew.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Emergency Management and Purchasing that the Commissioners Court approval renewal of RFP No. 2021-051, Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction, Disposal, and Other Emergency Debris Related Services, for another twelve (12) month period.
