[Click here to view awarded grantees and fund amounts](#). The grant term for this award will be from January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023. **Please carefully read the details below:**

Preparing to Accept Your Grant Award:

HUD will issue the official **Notice of Award** (NOA) through the Grants Management Module (GMM) found within Grant Solutions (GS). GMM is a web-based system that allows authorized users to electronically sign the NOA and see the status of completed actions online over the course of the grant.

The **Authorizing Official Representative** (AOR) listed in your application will be the *only* person able to accept the NOA in GMM. **However, if your agency needs to change the AOR from the one included in your FY2022 application, please see below for the steps you must take by January 11, 2023.**

PLEASE NOTE: The NOA has not yet been sent to you. HUD will notify you after sending it and will provide instructions once your Authorizing Official is able to accept the award by electronically signing the NOA in GMM.

Instructions for Making Changes to Your AOR:

If your agency needs to change the AOR from the one included in your FY2022 FSS application, **you must email FSS@hud.gov by January 11, 2023.** The subject line must read "Change AOR - FY22 FSS" and the body of the email must include the following information regarding the new AOR:

- AOR's First and Last Name
- AOR's Phone number
- AOR's Email address
- AOR's Position Title (i.e., Executive Director)
