



## **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tarrant County, that the Criminal District Attorney's Protective Order Unit Program be operated for the 2023 fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Violence Against Women Formula Grants application; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County approves submission of the grant application for the Protective Order Unit to the Office of the Governor.
