## RESOLUTION

State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division Juvenile Justice and Truancy Prevention Grant Application

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tarrant County, that an application for funds made available by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Truancy Prevention through the Governor's Office for the operation of the Reconnecting Youth Program be approved for the fiscal year 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County approves submission of the grant application for the Juvenile Justice and Truancy Prevention Grant Application Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
