

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
TARRANT COUNTY AND TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY
HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER**

Tarrant County ("COUNTY") and Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center ("SUBRECIPIENT"), each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties" to a Subrecipient Agreement related to the use of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds ("FRF Funds") now wish to amend the Agreement (the "Agreement"). This amendment is effective upon the signature of the Parties:

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2022, through Court Order No. 139799, COUNTY approved an agreement with SUBRECIPIENT; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY wishes to amend that agreement to reallocate funds from equipment/capital expenditures to professional services to improve SUBRECIPIENT's ability to train students at the Mansfield BSN program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

2. Except as modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in effect.
