RESOLVED, THAT WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has received and reviewed the plans for a public project known as Wichita Street located between SE Loop 820 (I-20) and Roy C. Brooks Boulevard in Tarrant County, Texas, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that in order to promote the public safety, to facilitate the safety and movement of traffic and to preserve the financial investment of Tarrant County, Texas, in its roadways, a public necessity exists for the location, alignment, construction, operation and maintenance of Wichita Street in accordance with said plans;

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND DECREED that in order to promote the public safety, to facilitate the safety and movement of traffic and to preserve the financial investment of Tarrant County, Texas, in its roadways, a public necessity exists for the accomplishment of a public project known as Wichita Street, that the plans for the location, alignment, construction, operation and maintenance of said project hereby be approved; that public necessity requires the acquisition by donation, purchase, condemnation or otherwise of the land and improvements, if any, located within the alignment of said projects; that the Right of Way Section of the Tarrant County Transportation Services Department is authorized to obtain and make payment for appraisals, engineering reports, surveys, title information, closing costs, removal of improvements, relocation, environmental testing, utility relocation and/or any other necessary or appropriate items, to secure by donation, if possible, and/or to make an official offer of a specific amount for the purchase of either an easement or the fee simple interest in and to each separate tract situated within such alignment, that the Criminal District Attorney be and is hereby authorized and directed to file or cause to be filed, to spend all reasonable and necessary legal expenses, and to carry through to final judgment, proceedings in eminent domain and to acquire thereby an easement or the fee simple interest for said purposes in each of said tracts which cannot be acquired as aforesaid by donation or purchase; that the Right of Way Section of the Transportation Services Department, the Criminal District Attorney, the County and District Clerks, and the County Auditor be and are hereby authorized and directed to perform any and all necessary acts within their respective spheres of official duties towards the final acquisition of each and all of the tracts of land, or interest therein, together with the improvements, if any, thereon, within the alignment of said projects and the payment of compensation therefore, further, it does not obligate Tarrant County, Texas to spend any specific amount of money on the above-described project.
