

RFB 2019-157 Base Price Clarification

We the undersigned agree that OPIS prices to be used as the base price before differential rates are added (referenced on Page 14 of RFB 2019-157 ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR FLEET FUEL CARD AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES, Items III.A and III.B.1) refer to the following:

The Thursday afternoon close retail average for OPIS Retail Region Average Report for reformulated unleaded regular gasoline purchases made between 12:00 am the Friday before the afternoon close report and 11:59pm the Thursday of the afternoon close report.

The Thursday afternoon close retail average for OPIS Retail Region Average Report for reformulated unleaded mid-grade gasoline purchases made between 12:00 am the Friday before the afternoon close report and 11:59pm the Thursday of the afternoon close report.

The Thursday afternoon close retail average for OPIS Retail Region Average Report for TxLED diesel purchases made between 12:00 am the Friday before the afternoon close report and 11:59pm the Thursday of the afternoon close report.

As a reference to which purchases fall under a particular report's average, the average of a report published on a Thursday which is the seventh (7th) calendar day of the month would include purchases made between the first (1st) and seventh (7th) days of that month. The average of a report published on a Thursday which is the fourteenth (14th) calendar day of the month would include purchases made between the eighth (8th) and fourteenth (14th) days of that month.
