

Proclamation

TXU Energy Aid

WHEREAS, this year marks the 40th Anniversary for the TXU Energy Aid program; and

WHEREAS, established in 1983, TXU Energy Aid is the largest bill-payment assistance program among electricity providers in the United States; and

WHEREAS, this nationally recognized program earned the 2012 National Fuel Funds Network Award for outstanding achievement; and

WHEREAS, TXU Energy Aid has provided more than \$128 million in bill-payment assistance to qualified low-income customers, helping more than 620,000 Texas families since its inception; and

WHEREAS, contributions from TXU Energy allow Tarrant County funds to be leveraged 4 to 1 with 100 percent of dedicated funds going towards families in need; and

WHEREAS, TXU Energy is contributing an additional \$4 million to be used in 2023 for electricity aid which will be important during harsh summer temperatures; and

WHEREAS, TXU Energy's commitment to service goes far beyond providing electricity, it also invests in the communities it serves through programs that help consumers pay their electricity bills during times of financial need, contribute to economic development activities, and improves the health and welfare of thousands of people every year through corporate donations and the generosity of its employees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, July 18, 2023, as TXU Energy Aid Day throughout Tarrant County and recognize the difference they have made in the lives of families.
