RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEXAS SOLAR FOR ALL CONSORTIUM

WHEREAS, Tarrant County acknowledges the burden energy costs place on many of the county's most vulnerable residents; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will begin accepting requests for proposals in the summer of 2023 from eligible entities to compete for funds from the "Clean Communities Investment Accelerator" and "Solar for All" grant competitions, funded through the 2022 Inflation Reduction Act; and

WHEREAS, significant financial and technical resources are and will be made available through the Environmental Protection Agency's Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund and other related federal programs; and

WHEREAS, the potential historic investment engendered by the competitive grant is understood to best be accessed collectively via a Texas county consortium; and

WHEREAS, Tarrant County has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tarrant County Commissioners Court authorizes the participation of Tarrant County as an original member of the "Texas Solar for All Consortium."
