



## TARRANT COUNTY

### RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN HARRIS COUNTY'S SOLAR FOR ALL GRANT APPLICATION

**WHEREAS**, Tarrant County acknowledges the burden energy costs place on many of the county's most vulnerable residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) included \$27 billion for the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF), \$7 billion of which will be available to applicants through the "Solar for All" grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, Harris County, Texas, submitted the required Notice of Intent (NOI) for a coalition of counties, cities, and nonprofit partners across the state; and

**WHEREAS**, Dallas County, Texas, has been designated the North Texas Lead for the coalition's grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, Tarrant County has analyzed the program and finds it in the public interest to secure these funds for the Tarrant County community; and

**WHEREAS**, Dallas County will work with Tarrant County and our community partners to implement Solar for All programs in our community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tarrant County Commissioners Court seeks to secure funding for the Tarrant County community through the Harris County led grant application, work with Dallas County to develop applicable programs, and collaborate with Tarrant County local governments and nonprofits to administer and implement Solar for All programs in the community.
