

**AMENDMENT NO. 6 TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
TARRANT COUNTY AND TRINITY METRO**

This Sixth Amendment (“Amendment No.6”) is entered into effective as of September 19, 2023, between Tarrant County, Texas (“COUNTY”) and Trinity Metro (“TRINITY METRO”).

COUNTY and FORT WORTH TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (dba TRINITY METRO) entered into that certain Interlocal Agreement No. ILA071, approved by Commissioners Court on August 22, 2017, Commissioners Court Order Number 125878, for Juror Shuttle Bus Service.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties desire to extend the agreement for an additional term beginning on October 1, 2023, and ending on September 30, 2024. COUNTY agrees to pay TRINITY METRO a maximum annual amount of \$360,096.00 to be paid in monthly payments of \$30,008.00 payable before the first day of each month, except for October 2023, which will be payable before November 1, 2023.


