1. *Four (4) court case records, dated 1988-1989, donated by the Tarrant County Justice of the Peace Court, Precinct 4.*

These four (4) civil court cases related to outstanding debts where companies were collecting debt from individuals in the community. These court cases document legal actions taken by the Justice of the Peace Court in Precinct 4, as well as the companies and individuals represented within them.

2. *Digital scan images of six (6) portraits of Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collectors, donated by the Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office.*

The Tax Assessor-Collector agreed to allow Tarrant County Archives scan, retain digital copies of, and provide digital files to a patron, of the Tax Assessor-Collector portraits they have hanging in the Administration Building. The portraits represent all the Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collectors from 1938 to present day.

3. *Oil painting of the Texas Spring Palace by Orin A. McCormick, dated 1889, donated by the University of Texas at Arlington Libraries Special Collections.*

In the early 2000s, the Tarrant County Historical Commission partnered with the University of Texas at Arlington Special Collections to restore this badly damaged painting of the Texas Spring Palace. In 2008, the painting was loaned to Tarrant County for display in the 1895 Room of the 1895 Courthouse. As the loan term was ending in 2023, University of Texas at Arlington agreed to donate the painting to the Tarrant County Archives so that it can remain on display at the Courthouse. This painting is one of the few images showing the bustling nature of Fort Worth's Texas Spring Palace, which was built in 1889 and burned down in 1890.

4. *Over 1,000 issues of the Wedgwood Shopping News (1965-2012), and a few issues of the Ridglea Shopping News (1988-2010) and City View Shopping News (1997-2016) newspapers, and other ephemera and publications related to the Wedgwood neighborhood, donated by the Wedgwood Historical Association.*

The Wedgwood Historical Association strives to preserve the history and historical nature of the Wedgwood neighborhood. With this donation the Wedgwood Historical Association has established the Tarrant County Archives as the repository for the Wedgwood Historical Association archives. The *Wedgwood Shopping News* and other newspapers document the minor details of living in this historic neighborhood, including individuals, businesses, and culture over time. Other Wedgwood related ephemera and publications document the homes and real-estate listings, and events in the neighborhood.

5. *Oral history interview and series of photographs related to Fort Worth Frosted Foods and the Public Market Building, donated by Jimmy Klein.*

Jimmy Klein reached out to the Tarrant County Archives to conduct an oral history interview related to the Public Market Building in Fort Worth, as the building is entering a period of construction to take on a new purpose. Klein's family owned the Fort Worth Frosted Foods (later Klein Meat Company) company that was housed in the Public Market Building from 1941 through 1969, and later in a building on Cullen Drive in Fort Worth. The interview and

photographs share an image of the Public Market Building that is not readily known to the public and is not well documented elsewhere. In the oral history, Klein also shares stories of growing up in Fort Worth, his knowledge of many of the business owners from the 1940s onward, and how the community has changed over time.

6. *Lithograph of painting *The Old and the New*, by Hal Warrick, 222/560, dated 1999, donated by John and Lynda Hill.*

A plaque on the frame states that this lithograph of the painting *The Old and the New* by Hal Warrick was presented to Judge John Hill because of his status as a Fellow of the Tarrant County Bar Foundation. The original painting and the lithographs were commissioned by Charles M. Noteboom. The lithograph is signed "To: Judge John Hill / Hal Warrick 1/26/99." The lithograph depicts the Old Civil Courts Building with its trompe l'oeil exterior, and a slight view of the 1895 Courthouse standing next to it. The building no longer stands, and this lithograph offers a wonderful representation of the building as well as the appreciation of the building from the judges who used to work there.

7. *Set of yearbooks, scrapbooks, and digital images related to Kennedale Independent School District and the City of Kennedale, donated by the Kennedale Historical Society.*

With no suitable place to house their archival materials, the Kennedale Historical Society is partnering with the Tarrant County Archives to create the Kennedale Historical Society Collection. This first donation to the collection features yearbooks from Kennedale Independent School District, including the first yearbook from the district published in 1942. Scrapbooks within this donation relate to Kennedale schools and PTA, and document many of the programs and happenings at the schools. Scrapbooks date from the 1980s to 2000s. Digital images are scans of photographs of Kennedale school classes from the early 1900s. The Tarrant County Archives does not hold many materials related to Kennedale, so the addition of this collection fills a gap in the county historical record.

8. *Series of documents and images from research conducted on William Reeves, donated by Peggy Gaskamp.*

Peggy Gaskamp began researching William Reeves in 2003 after moving into the house he built around 1895 in Caldwell, Texas. The house received a Texas historical marker in 1983, and a National Register of Historic Places designation in 1992. William Reeves, born 1859, lived in Caldwell County prior to moving to Tarrant County where he founded the First Fort Worth Bank and Trust, and built what is now known as the Reeves-Walker house where he lived in Fort Worth. Documents and images donated relate to Reeves's life, work, and home.

9. *Series of digital files and images related to the Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collector history, donated by Devin Pipes.*

Donation consists of digital materials related to the history of individual Tax Assessor-Collectors for Tarrant County, as well as the history of the office of Tax Assessor-Collector. Digital materials include photographs and scans of newspaper clippings, photographs, and documents which represent the history of Tarrant County and these individuals that served in the Tax Assessor-Collector position.
