

Effective for appointments made on September 20, 2023, and thereafter, counsel appointed to represent indigent defendants shall be compensated for their services as follows:

Appointment	\$75
Family Violence	\$350
DWI	\$350
Uncontested Revocation	\$200
Other	\$200
Evidentiary Hearing	\$100

Criminal Law Board-Certified Attorney \$100 per invoice

Trial by Court/Jury Trial \$600 per day \$300 for half day

Appeals \$50-125 per hour, not to exceed \$1,800

Counsel appointed to represent indigent defendants prior to September 20, 2023, shall be compensated for their services pursuant to the fee schedule in effect at the time of appointment.

If the charging instrument alleges different charges in separate counts, the attorney may be compensated for each count under one case number by specifying the count number. The attorney may not be compensated twice for board certification or for hearings and trials that involve all counts.
