A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS, TEXAS APPROVING ENTERING INTO BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING THROUGH THE TARRANT COUNTY 2021 TRANSPORTATION BOND PROGRAM (2021 TBP) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE INDIVIDUAL FUNDING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS FOR BLACK OAK LANE RECONSTRUCTION (ROBERTS CUT OFF ROAD TO GILLHAM ROAD), YALE STREET RECONSTRUCTION, GLENWICK DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION, GREENBRIER DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION, ALMENA ROAD RECONSTRUCTION, THURSTON ROAD RECONSTRUCTION, BAYLOR AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION AND ROBERTS CUT OFF ROAD RECONSTRUCTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of River Oaks is a home rule city acting under its Charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Black Oak Lane (Roberts Cut Off Road to Gillham Road) at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$109,619.10; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Yale Street at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$343,525.00; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare

of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Glenwick Drive at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$102,098.46; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Greenbrier Drive at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$128,424.48; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Almena Road at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$164,282.34; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Thurston Road at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$137,630.10; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing

body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Baylor Avenue at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$103,006.26; and

WHEREAS, An Interlocal Agreement is entered into between Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for the purpose of providing funding through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) to a needed transportation project within the boundaries of both parties which the Commissioners Court of Tarrant County and the governing body of the City of River Oaks finds to serve a public purpose and promotes the public welfare of the citizens of both Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks for reconstruction and asphalt overlay of Roberts Cut Off Road at a 50% reimbursement from Tarrant County to the City of River Oaks in an amount not to exceed \$118,730.54; and

WHEREAS, the City of River Oaks and Tarrant County desires to enter into all of these Interlocal Agreements under the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) for the purpose of providing funding for the needed transportation projects as herein attached to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, with the adoption of this Resolution, the Mayor has been authorized to execute the individual Funding Interlocal Agreements for Black Oak Lane, Yale Street, Glenwick Drive, Greenbrier Drive, Almena Road, Thurston Road, Baylor Avenue and Roberts Cut Off Road reconstruction projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVER OAKS, TEXAS:

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With the adoption of this Resolution Tarrant County and the City of River Oaks desire enter into funding interlocal agreements for the financial support through the Tarrant County 2021 Transportation Bond Program (2021 TBP) for reconstruction and asphalt overlay projects involving streets located within the City of River Oaks as follows:

- Black Oak Ln. (from Roberts Cut-Off Rd. to Gilham Rd)- No ILA
- Yale St. (Roberts Cut-Off Rd. to River Oaks Blvd) No ILA
- Glenwick Dr. (from Thurston Rd to River Oaks Blvd) No ILA
- Greenbrier Dr. (from Thurston Rd to River Oaks Blvd) No ILA
- Almena Rd. (from Roberts Cut-Off to Long Ave.) NO ILA
- Thurston Rd. (from Skyline Dr. to Long Ave.) No ILA

- Baylor Ave (from Roberts Cut Off Rd. west to dead end) No ILA
- Roberts Cut-Off Rd. (Ohio Garden Rd. to River Oaks Blvd) No ILA

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With the adoption of this Resolution, the Mayor has been authorized to execute the individual Funding Interlocal Agreements with Tarrant County for Black Oak Lane, Yale Street, Glenwick Drive, Greenbrier Drive, Almena Road, Thurston Road, Baylor Avenue and Roberts Cut Off Road reconstruction projects.

III.

This Resolution shall be effective upon its passage by a majority vote of the City Council.
