KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Marshall Marketing Services, Inc. EMC Integrated Systems Group (hereinafter called the Principal), as principal, and EMPLOYERS MUTUAL CASUALTY COMPANY or UNION INSURANCE COMPANY OF PROVIDENCE a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Iowa, licensed to do business in the State of Texas and admitted to write bonds, as surety, (hereinafter called the Surety), are held firmly bound unto Tarrant County

(hereinafter called the Obligee), in the amount of

Seventy one thousand three hundred thirty nine and 98/100 Dollars (\$ 71,339.98) for the payment whereof, the said Principal and Surety bind themselves, and their heirs, administrators, executors, successors, and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents:

Tarrant County Public Health Complex which contract is hereby referred to and made a part hereof as fully and to the same extent as if copied at length herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the said Principal shall promptly make payments to all claimants as defined in Chapter 2253 of the Texas Government Code, as amended by the 73rd Legislature 1993, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect;

PROVIDED, HOWEVER that this bond is executed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2253 of the Texas Government Code and all liabilities on this bond shall be determined in accordance with the provisions, conditions and limitations of said article to the same extent as if it were copied at length herein.

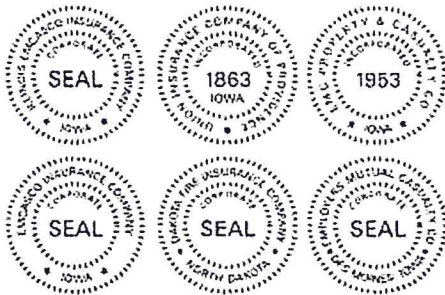
AUTHORITY FOR POWER OF ATTORNEY






