COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court accept a in-kind donation in the amount of \$2,350.00 from the Sheriff's Foundation of Tarrant County which will enable five (5) Tarrant County Sheriff's Office Deputies to attend a "Sig Sauer Armorer's Course" to be held at the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office Training Academy on April 6, 2022 and April 7, 2022.

BACKGROUND

Five (5) Tarrant County Sheriff's Office Deputies plan to attend the "Sig Sauer Armorer's Course" to be held at the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office Training Academy on April 6, 2022 and April 7, 2022. Mr. Nichols, who sits on the board of the Sheriff's Foundation of Tarrant County, and the Foundation itself, are willing to pay the course attendance fees for the five (5) deputies. This is an in-kind donation as the Foundation will be paying the non-Tarrant County Sheriff's Office instructor directly on behalf of the attending Tarrant County Sheriff's Office personnel. It should be noted that Mr. Nichols and the Sheriff's Foundation have previously made donations to the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office. The total in-kind donation is \$2,350.00 which is the cost for five (5) Deputies to attend this training.

Texas Local Government Code, Section 81.032, allows the Commissioners Court to accept donations for the purpose of performing a function conferred by law on the county or county officer. To ensure compliance with this statute, the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office is requesting the acceptance of the donation for this training.
