It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Amendment No. 3 to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 TBLA 114 Continuum of Care (CoC) grant subrecipient contract between Tarrant County and The Salvation Army for tenant-based leasing assistance for households experiencing homelessness in Tarrant County, increasing the contract amount to \$347,368.00 at the request of the agency.

BACKGROUND

On May 25, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135511, approved the original contract between Tarrant County and The Salvation Army for the TBLA 114 program.

On July 20, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135844, approved an amendment to the Term of Agreement Section of the Contract.

On February 8, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #137446, approved an amendment to the Term of Agreement section of the Contract.

With approval, this amendment will increase funds for the subrecipient to provide assistance to households experiencing homelessness in the amount stated below. These services include rapid rehousing, rental assistance, transportation, and general case management. Tarrant County is the recipient for the project.
