SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND THE CITY OF CROWLEY TO PARTICIPATE IN URBAN COUNTIES' TECHSHARE.JUVENILE PROGRAM

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that Commissioners Court approve the 2022 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Tarrant County Juvenile Services and the City of Crowley Police Department for the purpose of participation in the Urban Counties' TechShare.Juvenile Program.

BACKGROUND

Tarrant County implemented TechShare.Juvenile (JCMS) on September 17, 2011. This new statewide juvenile case management system is used to collect juvenile data and report dispositions throughout the state. The system also allows Law Enforcement Agencies (LEA) to access statewide data and electronically file cases to juvenile probation departments.

The Memorandum of Understanding with Crowley Police Department outlines provisions for the agency to file cases electronically with the department.

This MOU has been reviewed as to form by the Criminal District Attorney's Office and approved by the Tarrant County Juvenile Board at the April 20, 2022 Board meeting.
