It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Program Year (PY) 2021 Continuum of Care (CoC) Contract between Tarrant County and The Salvation Army Mabee Center for the TBLA 114 Rapid Rehousing (RRH) program in the amount of \$60,000.00.

BACKGROUND

In Fall 2021, Tarrant County, through the Community Development Division, in conjunction with the City of Fort Worth, City of Arlington and the Tarrant County Homeless Coalition (TCHC), applied for funding for the above-named project. The application was made in response to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD's) Continuum of Care (CoC) Homeless Assistance Programs request for proposals.

On March 8, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #137635, approved interim financing for CoC renewal grants expiring and in the process of finalization to maintain continuity of services.

This grant will provide The Salvation Army Mabee Center with the resources to assist eighteen (18) households experiencing homelessness. These services include rental assistance, transportation, and general case management. Tarrant County is the recipient for the project.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed this contract as to form.

FISCAL IMPACT

County funds utilized for interim funding will be reimbursed by the appropriate grant upon Commissioners Court approval of the grant renewal. Each funded agency is required to fulfill any match requirements.
