COURTESY PATROL PROGRAM**

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Amendment Number Two to the Interlocal Contract between Tarrant County and the Texas Department of Transportation for the Courtesy Patrol Program.

BACKGROUND

The Courtesy Patrol Program provides a valuable service to the motorists of Tarrant County by clearing roadways of debris and inoperable vehicles, assisting stalled and stranded motorists, and assisting law enforcement with traffic control when deemed necessary or as requested by law enforcement.

On July 2, 2019, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #130541, approved the current Interlocal Contract with the Texas Department of Transportation for the Courtesy Patrol Program.

On July 26, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #138685, approved Amendment Number One to the Interlocal Contract, extending the term beyond the designated end date of August 31, 2022 to October 31, 2022.

Amendment Number Two is identical to Amendment Number 1, which was inadvertently signed by TxDOT, at authority level, below that required by statute. This amendment is to merely allow the ratification of Amendment Number 1 by the correct signature authority. A new Interlocal Contract is in the process of being created for the period after the end date of October 31, 2022.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed Amendment Number 2 as to form.
