## COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve a Subrecipient Contract between Tarrant County and Safe City Commission, d/b/a One Safe Place for services related to the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE), Grant Contract No. HHS000897700004.

## **BACKGROUND**

On September 29, 2020, the Commissioners Court, though Court Order #133855, approved the FY 2021 DSHS EHE grant contract which provided funding in the amount of \$637,328.00 for the term of August 1, 2020 through July 31, 2021 to strategically advance HIV prevention and surveillance efforts. This included funding for subcontracting of these efforts.

On June 1, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court order #135579, approved Amendment No.1 to the contract, adding funding in the amount of \$637,328.00 for FY 2022, decreasing funding by \$232,000.00 for FY 2021, and extending the contract term though July 31, 2023.

On September 21, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136406, approved the posting of a Request for Application for EHE Sub-Awards.

On April 26, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #137993, approved Amendment No. 2 to the contract, adding funding in the amount of \$637,328.00 for FY 2023.

With approval of this Subrecipient Contract, One Safe Place will receive funding in the amount of \$40,000.00 to be used to help inform and empower Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) survivors, social service providers, and others about the intersection of HIV and IPV. The contract term is August 1, 2022, through July 31, 2023.
