COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve an Interagency Agreement (ILA) between Tarrant County, d/b/a Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office (TCCDA) and the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

BACKGROUND

Beginning October 1, 2002, the former Tarrant County Narcotics Unit (TCNU) and the DEA entered into agreements whereby TCNU assigned one (1) investigator to the DEA/Fort Worth Multi-Agency Task Force. Under the terms of the new proposed agreement, the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office will provide an assigned investigator. The DEA provides space, office supplies, travel funds, funds for the purchase of evidence and information, equipment, training and overtime pay for the investigator beginning October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2026.

On September 7, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #136229, approved the most recent agreement for the term of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

With approval of this ILA, one (1) investigator will be assigned to the DEA/Fort Worth Multi-Agency Task Force and the DEA will provide for incidental expenses as outlined above. The new term of the ILA is October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2026

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed this document.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item as the DEA reimburses overtime expenditures for the assigned officer.
