SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE SUBRECIPIENT CONTRACT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND THE FATHERHOOD COALITION OF TARRANT COUNTY FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION GRANT FOR COVID-19 HEALTH DISPARITIES

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Amendment No. 1 to the Subrecipient Contract between Tarrant County and the Fatherhood Coalition of Tarrant County (FCTC) for services related to the Centers for Disease Control grant for COVID-19 health disparities.

BACKGROUND

On June 8, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135624, approved a notice of award for grant funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to address COVID-19 health disparities among underserved and high risk populations and rural communities in Tarrant County.

On November 9, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139647, approved the Subrecipient Contract between Tarrant County and the Fatherhood Coalition of Tarrant County for grant funding in the amount of \$368,830.00.

With approval of Amendment No. 1 to the contract, the Tarrant County Auditor authorizes to release advanced funding in the amount of \$36,810.56 to FCTC, to be used for materials and supplies. The balance of the remaining funding will be \$332,019.44.

The Criminal District Attorney's Office has reviewed this document as to form.

FISCAL IMPACT

All associated costs will be paid from grant fund allocations in F0102-2023. There will be no fiscal impact to the County's General Fund.
