### **COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve Hart InterCivic, Inc. as sole source for Hart InterCivic Verity Voting System and associated software, hardware, accessories, consumables, maintenance, and repair, for Elections Administration.

# BACKGROUND

Hart InterCivic, Inc. is the provider of the Hart InterCivic Verity Voting System. The system and services include voting equipment, certified by the Secretary of State's Office, software, accessories, on-site technical support, and solution-specific consumables that are part of the certified solution, such as ballot paper. The Verity Voting System allows Elections Administration to administer elections effectively and accurately in Tarrant County by providing a platform that can be used by any voter to cast their vote, regardless of disability, while still providing a verifiable paper trail. The system provides an easy, reliable, and verifiable method for tallying election results while maintaining the security of the voted ballots.

Hart InterCivic, Inc. provided the Purchasing Agent documentation to substantiate the fact that they are the sole source for Hart InterCivic Verity Voting System (Verity) and its associated software, hardware, accessories, consumables, maintenance, and repair. The letter states that the Verity software applications are a proprietary group of products necessary for an authorized Hart InterCivic, Inc. customer to accomplish ballot creation, election management, tabulation, and maintenance of the Verity equipment. The letter further states that the license, support, maintenance, repairs, thermal paper, and ballots are only available from Hart InterCivic, Inc.

Under the County Purchasing Act, exemptions to the competitive bidding requirements are allowed for certain types of purchases. The statutes require that the Purchasing Agent advise the Commissioners Court of the existence of only one (1) source, with such notice to be entered into the minutes of the Court.

Accordingly, the above item has been determined to be sole source under the County Purchasing Act 262.024(a)(7) as follows:



- "(7) an item can be obtained from only one (1) source, including:
  - items for which competition is precluded because of the (A)
    - existence of patents, copyrights, secret processes, or monopolies;
  - captive replacement parts or components for equipment" (D)

## FISCAL IMPACT

Expenses for last year were approximately \$1,533,597.94. There is no immediate fiscal impact associated with this item. The County's future costs will be determined on an as-needed basis. Funding is available in various accounts for Cost Center 1420000000.
