It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve the renewal of the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Community Preparedness Section /Cities Readiness Initiative - Public Health Emergency Preparedness (CPS/CRI-PHEP) Grant Contract, No. 537-18-0145-00001 for FY 2024 funding.

BACKGROUND

Historically, Tarrant County Public Health (TCPH) has received annual funding from DSHS through various grant contracts to perform a variety of essential public health services. The CPS/CRI-PHEP grant contract supports the operation of the activities of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Cooperative Agreement from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

TCPH received notification from DSHS that FY 2024 funding for the CPS/CRI-PHEP grant will be \$341,456.00. If renewed, the grant period would begin July 1, 2023 and end June 30, 2024. This grant requires a ten percent (10%) match in the amount of \$34,145.00

With approval, TCPH will provide a budget template and contract renewal checklist template to DSHS as a requirement to renew the CPS/CRI-PHEP grant contract for FY 2024 funding. Funding will be used to maintain current staffing levels and provide needed materials used to meet grant deliverables.

FISCAL IMPACT

In addition to the grant of \$341,456.00 in federal funding (F0044-2024), grant match funds of \$34,145.00 will be provided by Public Health funds in T0410-2024.
