**SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - TO CONSIDER AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE PROGRAM YEAR 2021 ACTION PLAN – COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court conduct a public hearing to consider Amendment No. 4 adding the HOME-American Rescue Plan (ARP) Allocation Plan to the Program Year (PY) 2021 Action Plan. Upon closure of the public hearing, the Commissioners Court authorizes the execution of any necessary documents as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

**BACKGROUND**

On March 30, 2021, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #135101, approved the PY 2021 Action Plan for Community Development to fulfill HUD regulatory requirements for 47th Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs.

Public comments will be received regarding Amendment No. 4 to the PY 2021 Action Plan. The substantial amendment will add the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to the PY 2021 Action Plan, which outlines the range of eligible activities for the \$5,281,656.00 in HOME-ARP funding for the Tarrant County Consortium. HOME-ARP funding provides HOME grantees, in collaboration with other community stakeholders, a chance to make targeted, strategic investments for people experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable populations.

The amendment process to add the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to the PY 2021 Action Plan includes a public notice, a fifteen (15) day public comment period, and a public hearing. Public comment will be received through the closing of the public hearing.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no fiscal impact to Tarrant County. Costs associated with administration of this amendment and costs of eligible activities will be paid with grant funds through grant M21-DP480200.
