**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF INTERIM FINANCING FOR FUNDING YEAR 2022  
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT  
CONTINUUM OF CARE TBLA 114 AND 3CP RENTAL  
ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

## **COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED**

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve interim financing for Funding Year (FY) 2022 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Continuum of Care (CoC) TBLA 114 and 3CP programs which provide rental assistance and services for homeless individuals and families in Tarrant County.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Tarrant County Community Development (TCCD) department receives annual funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide leasing and supportive services related to housing homeless individuals and families in Tarrant County. A portion of these services, such as case management, rent and utility assistance, are provided through contracts with local nonprofit subrecipient agencies.

In previous years, HUD renewal documents for these grants have lagged several months behind, necessitating interim funding to allow for continuity of services. In every case, when Tarrant County has approved interim funding for these grants, the amounts have been reimbursed without issue once the grant documents with HUD are executed.

The current TBLA 114 and 3CP grants expire April 30, 2023, and March 31, 2023, respectively. HUD is in the process of finalizing the funding announcement and issuing grant documents, however TCCD does not anticipate receiving funding until June 1, 2023. To prevent a gap in service provision and allow subrecipient agencies to continue their work under these grants until the renewal documents are executed, TCCD requests interim financing as follows:
