SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN TARRANT COUNTY AND ALLIANCE FOR CHILDREN FUNDED BY TARRANT COUNTY'S FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS PROGRAM

COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve the second amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement with Alliance for Children for to expand available program space, funded by Tarrant County's Fiscal Recovery Funds program.

BACKGROUND

On February 8, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #137435, approved a subrecipient agreement between Tarrant County and Alliance for Children. The agreement provided Alliance for Children with FRF funds to expand and renovate existing investigative locations in Arlington and Hurst, provide Spanish-speaking interpretive services, and implement interrogation training to better provide child advocacy services for alleged child abuse victims and their protective caregivers through December 31, 2024.

On August 9, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #138748, approved the first amendment to the agreement, providing additional funding to expand the scope of renovations to include additional space.

As a result of this action, funds within the approved program budget will be reallocated from personnel and fringe to contractual to respond to the increased cost of construction and assist with completion of the Alliance for Children Arlington investigative facility.

This amendment has been approved as to form by the Criminal District Attorney's Office.
