COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the Commissioners Court approve the termination of the Subrecipient Contract between Tarrant County and Fatherhood Coalition of Tarrant County (FCTC) for services related to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention grant for COVID-19 health disparities.

BACKGROUND

On November 8, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139647, approved a Subrecipient Contract with FCTC for services related to the COVID-19 health disparities grant. The contract terms are October 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023.

On December 6, 2022, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #139844, approved advanced funding to FCTC in the amount of \$36,810.56, to be used for materials and supplies.

On January 24, 2023, FCTC requested termination of their subcontract, effective February 28, 2023 because the organization is unable to fulfill the cost reimbursement requirement as stipulated in the contract. All grant activities ceased on February 28, 2023, and the Centers for Disease Control was made aware.

With approval, the Subrecipient contract between Tarrant County and FCTC will be terminated.
